## Proof for Implementation of guidelines of statutory/regulatory bodies

### (a) Prohibition of Ragging in Educational institutions Disciplinary

#### Act:

#### Salient Features:

- Prohibition of Ragging within or outside educational institution.
- Without permission no entry is allowed within college and hostel premises.
- It is compulsory uniform for all students and to carry identity cards and need to show on demand.
- Girl students must be available in hostel rooms by 7 pm.
- The Hostel Wardens can inspect the rooms at any time.
- Before leaving the hostel, it is necessary for a student to submit declaration from parents to warden.

### (b) Detention of students from Internal and External Examinations:

#### Salient Features:

- Students Attendance in the classes must be maintained above 75% for internal examinations Semester Term Test (Internal Test-1 and Internal Test-2) separately.
- Student detained in both internal examinations Internal Test-1 and Internal Test-2 are not allowed for external examinations conducted by SNTWU, Mumbai.

### **(c) Reporting of Teaching and Non-teaching staff members:**

#### **Salient Features:**

- It is compulsory uniform for every teaching and non-teaching staff members.
- Every teaching and non-teaching staff members must do signature on attendance muster.

### **(d) Grievance submission and redressal:**

#### **Salient Features:**

- Grievance Form submitted to the concerned section in-charge in writing as per format.
- Action taken report must be submitted within stipulated time for the closure of grievance.
- Information about action taken must be communicated to the individual within stipulated time.

## AntiRagging: What Constitutes Ragging?

**Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:**

- a) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or in disciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- c) Asking any student to do any which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- b) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- i) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher.
- j) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of color, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.
